SUMMER ART CAMP

9 sessions will be held, each camp is a 1 week long.

Camps for Ages 5-10 9:00am-4:00pm

Session 1 & Session 5 “A Week at the Beach”

This camp will have a blast creating Beach Art! We will paint with Sand, Collage with shells and pebbles, paint our very own beach landscape, create a 3-D ocean scene, and finish the week with a Beach Canvas Bag.

Session 2 “Arts and Crafts”

This camp will incorporate a little bit of all of the above mentioned camps. Additionally, we will paint on wood items, canvas bags, clay pots, mask, and T-shirts. One white and washed T-shirt is required for this camp.

Session 3 & Session 9 “A Week under the Stars”

In this camp your child will create their very own “Van Gogh” Starry Night replication. Additionally, we will create an Outer Space 3-D piece of art work, We will work with Charcoal, create our very own painting of a “Full Moon”, and lastly we will finish the week off with an American Flag Painting.

Session 4 “A Week in the Life’s of Famous Artist”

This camp will have a blast painting like Miro, Pollack, Picasso, Matisse, Kandinsky, Andy Warhol, and many other famous artists. We will paint like the pros; learning their styles and techniques. We will work with Acrylics, Watercolors and water soluble pastels during this week.

Session 6 “Drawing in your World”

This camp will introduce the basics of how to draw in a very light and fun manner. Your child will learn a little bit about Mass Gesture, Continuous line, Blind Contour, Cartooning and much more. We will work with Charcoal, Pastels, Ink and Pencil. This camp will have limited painting.

Session 7 “Adventure Week”

This week will be all about exploring.....We will go on a Scavenger Hunt creating unique art from the items received; off to the park we go....we will need sticks, leaves, rocks, and acorns to create our very own collage of the outdoors. Additionally, we will create our very own map that will tell a story and create one of kind trading cards for Adventures that may arise in the future!

Session 8 “Opposites Attract” “Positive and Negative”

Black and White, Blue and Orange, Purple and Red ...what are opposites in art? What does Positive and Negative mean in art? In this camp your child will work with colors and concepts to create amazing artwork throughout the week. We will work will acrylics, pastels, charcoal and watercolor while learning about opposites and positive/ negative concepts.



Camps for Ages 11-15

Illustration– Session 1, 4 and 8- 9:00am – 12:00 pm

In This camp we will create a story and characters for a children's book. We will break down the story, thumbnails, storyboard, and work on personal style. Additionally, we will create a storyboard for their book idea while learning and utilizing Techniques for color pencil, Inking, Lettering and Layout. Lastly, we will create a Sketch Mock up of their book; by end of the week we will have one or two final Illustrations from storyboard in full color.

Design Concepts- Session 4 and 8-1:00pm- 4:00pm In this camp we will learn rip and tear design, curved line design, straight edge design, image design and anamorphic design utilizing black and white paper while incorporating ink.

Fashion Design Session 2 and 5- 9:00am-4:00pm

Please bring a white T-shirt (washed) and an old pair of jeans (note we will be painting and bedazzling both items of clothing). We will be creating sketches for our fashion line. We will have tags/labels to brand our fashion line. Additionally, we will create our very own fabric board choosing the most popular fabrics of the season.

Photography Session 3 and 9 – 9:00am-4:00pm

This camp will cover Composition, Aperture, Shutter Speed, Contrast, Photojournalism and Portraits. A Digital Camera is required for this camp.

Cartooning Session 6 and 7- 9:00 am – 12:00pm In this camp you will learn about the different types of cartoon styles, including Manga. We will learn how to draw cartoons through examples and discussion. We will develop a concept for characters and create a four panel strip cartoon sketch. Lastly, we will utilize Ink work techniques, and lettering techniques to create our final cartoon strip.

Printmaking Session 6-1:00pm- 4:00pm - In this camp you will create your own prints utilizing Foil, scratch board, fruit, vegetables, and cardboard. You will create interesting pieces of artwork while using acrylic paint.

Charcoal - Session 1 and 7-1:00 pm – 4:00pm In this camp you will work with black and white charcoal while learning and incorporating techniques such as mass gesture, blind contour, and shading, portraiture, and still life drawings.
